EVENT FORMAT

There are two divisions: Boys Scratch, Girls Scratch.

Bowlers will bowl a 6-game qualifying block across 16 lanes. The top 16 in each division will advance to 4 rounds of matchplay where four players will square off in a match with bonus pins awarded (45/30/15/0). After the 10 games, the top two bowlers plus a wild card in each division will bowl a 2 game total pin match to determine champion. The wildcard will be determined from survivor style eliminator seeds 3,4,5, and 6 (low ball eliminated each round).

Junior Gold Qualifer \$25 atleast 1:8 advancement ratio Separate divisions for U17B, U17G, U15B, U15G U20B, U20G if sufficient entries exist

RULES

All NWIJTPA rules will apply. If not specifically covered by NWIJTPA rules, USBC rules will be applied. NWIJTPA dress code will be enforced (dress slacks, collared shirt, no head wear, Ladies may wear skorts/skirts/dress shorts)

Must be USBC certified youth member to participate.

Junior Gold Qualifier - advancement ratio will be atleast 1:8. Cost to enter qualifier is \$25. Standings based on 6-game qualifying block. Qualifier open to both NWIJTPA members and non-members. If tie occurs for final JG advancing spot, a 1-game rolloff will take place. If both players advance to second round, game 7 will be used to break tie. If still tied, a 9th-10th frame rolloff will occur.

NWIJTPA members will have priority to event spots until deadline, then spots will be filled on first signed up basis. Bowler of the Year points will be awarded to participating members only based on NWIJTPA rules.
