

VOIERS EARNS FIRST TITLE WITH STELLAR FINALS PERFORMANCE

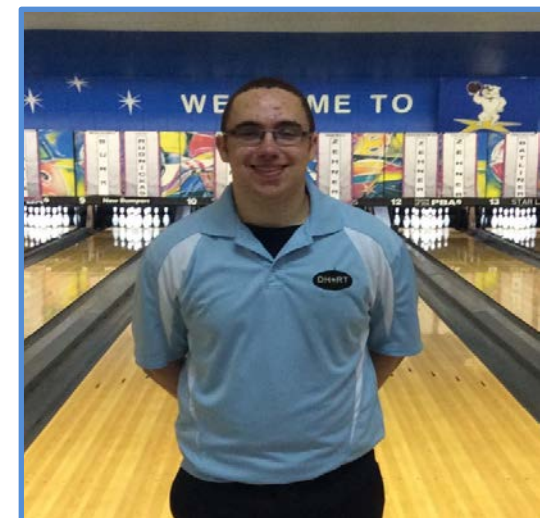
ZEHNER ADDS 8TH TITLE TO HIS RESUME

Chesterton's Sarah Voiers' rebounded from a near devastating 127 during the fourth game of qualifying with games of 179 and 173 to secure the 8th and final qualifying spot into the 2015 Lafayette Open eliminator championship round. The 2015 Indiana High School girls State Individual Runnerup then survived the quarterfinal round with a 153 which was her last sub-190 game of the event. The sophomore then turned up the heat on her fellow competitors by rolling a 196 in the semi-finals to advance to the championship round along with #4 seed Kasey Eaton (Grand Rapids, MI) who tossed a championship round best 211. The two were joined in the title match by top seeds Aubree Trexler and Becky Lohse. But the title match was all Voiers, as she tossed games of 191 and 202 to secure her first NWIJTPA title, outdistancing Eaton by 30 pins. Valparaiso University's Trexler claimed third while Chesterton junior Lohse settled for fourth.

Voiers earned \$250 in the event sponsored by Savage Bowling. Eaton collected \$175 for her runnerup finish. Other qualifiers on the girls side included third place finisher Trexler, 4th place finisher Lohse, 5th place Jackie Rhoda, Brooklynn Shutz, Annalee Sisk, and Nicole Walton

Trexler was the high qualifier, rolling an 1,134 (189.0 avg) while the girls field, as a group, averaged 164.1 on the WTBA Atlanta pattern.

The NWIJTPA's most prolific champion, Dustin Zehner, added yet another title to his already glistening NWIJTPA resume. The Purdue University freshman by way of South Bend, IN dominated qualifying with a 1,262 (210.3 avg) which was highlighted by a stellar 286 game, second highest ever recorded in NWIJTPA competition. Zehner outdistanced #2 seed Zachary Carter by over 130 pins. The championship match was no different as Zehner picked up right where he left off, rolling games of 241 and 220 to run past Austin Schultz (406), Carter (360), and Travis Holpuch (331).



Other qualifiers on the guys side included Greater Calumet Harsco Open Champion Jordan Shepherd, Lafayette's Jakob Sisk, Portage's Jordan Trent, and Grand Rapids MI native David Northouse.

Zehner earned \$275 in scholarship awards for his title while runnerup Austin Schultz collected \$175. In excess of \$1,600 was distributed in event scholarships and/or placed into the year end scholarship pool resulting in a payback ratio in excess of 110%.

A Junior Gold spot was awarded to Chad Burgess (Noblesville, IN).

In the battle of the sexes, the girls rebounded quickly from their rare defeat in Highland, to dismantle the boys 2-1. Despite the boys, jumping

out to a 1-0 lead on the strength of a 220 game, but the ladies rebounded with wins in game 2 (185-158) and game 3 (186-124). The ladies increased their series lead to 6-3. Members of the victorious girls squad included Voiers, Eaton, Lohse, Trexler, and Rhoda.
