

SISK, QUINN JR EARN FIRST NWIJTPA TITLES

GREATER CALUMET OPEN FEATURES MULTIPLE FIRSTS

Annalee Sisk (Rossville, IN) has been a member of the NWIJTPA tour for four years spanning 28 events. Without a victory to her credit, the Marian Knight gave it one last shot before "ageing out" at the 2017 Greater Calumet Open, and she did not disappoint. Following a nine-game qualifying block where her 1,728 secured her the fourth seed, and a spot in the championship round eliminator bracket.

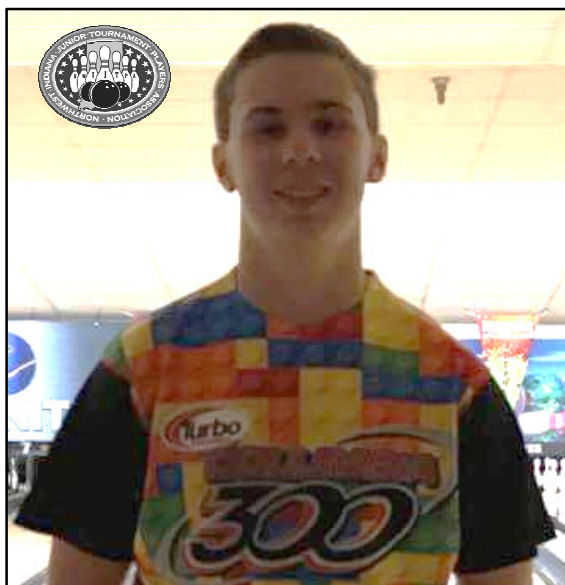
The initial match saw Sisk (202) and Bedford sophomore sensation Hallee Gabhart (219) moving onto the semi-finals as both outlasted two-time NWIJTPA Player of the Year Maryssa Carey (172). Portage junior Makayla Himden (#2 seed) joined the pair only to be eliminated in an electrifying one ball roll off with Gabhart (10-8) as both tied with 183's while Sisk rolled into the title match with a 209. Top Seed Nicolette Mendez (Youngstown State University), the event's defending champion entered the match and quickly learned that Sisk meant business. Sisk made quick work of both Gabhart and Mendez, starting with the front five enroute to a 223 and the title.

The field of 35 girls averaged 174 during the initial 6-game qualifying block. Once the field was trimmed to 12, the advancers round players averaged 188, with an average of 190.2 required to secure a spot in the final five. WTBA Rome was the pattern used.

Seven girls earned scholarship awards. In addition to Sisk (\$300), the others included Gabhart (\$200), Mendez (\$150), Himden (\$125), Maryssa Carey (\$100), Heather Waters (\$75), and Macailan Rodriguez (\$75). Mendez earned the high qualifier free entry award, while Mendez and Himden punched their ticket to Dallas, earning junior gold spots to the 2018 national championships.

On the guys side, Evergreen Park, IL's Shaun Quinn Jr, a Calumet College of St Joseph's recruit was competing in his first NWIJTPA event and he served notice to the tour's top guns with a display of power and accuracy enroute to his first title. The former Illinois high school star grabbed the #3 seed behind top seeded and Junior Team USA member Ryan Winters, and #2 seed Jordan Chavez (Cresthill, IL).

Quinn edged out Lawrence Tech star Jordan Bryant in the first round (191-182) to join Colgate WI's Brent Boho and Chavez in the semi-finals. It was here where Quinn Jr put the medal to the pedal, firing a 267 to easily advance and then 276 in the title match, leaving both Winters and Boho wondering what just happened.

Quinn collected \$400 while 11 boys earned scholarship awards. Winters earned \$275, Boho \$200, Chavez \$150, Bryant \$100, Nikolas Bowman (\$80) Alex Acosta (\$80), Zach Carter (\$80), Jacob Hubbs (\$80), U15 star Connor Pula (\$80), and Sean Taylor (\$80).

The boys field of 57 averaged 185 during qualifying and 200.1 during the advancers round. In all, 19 competitors made the initial cut. The member high qualifier award (free entry) went to Ryan Winters who fired an impressive 1,411 to lead all competitors.
