

# DELROSE SECURES BREAKTHROUGH WIN WITH CLUTCH FINISH

**Maryville standout punches ticket to winner's circle after 9 runnerup finishes**

Maryville University Sophomore standout Bailey Delrose can finally call herself an NWIJTPA champion. After 9 runnerup finishes, the Crest Hill, IL product, who has won on every other youth tour in Illinois, Wisconsin, and Iowa, punched her ticket to the winner's circle with a 245 - 234 - 205 win over fellow collegiate players Macailin Rodriguez and Serenity Quintero. Following a "flagged" 7-pin in the fourth frame of the championship match, Delrose found herself once again looking up at her Maryville running mate Rodriguez as Rodriguez thru 6 was on pace for 290. But then Rodriguez opened the door with a blown 10-pin in the 7th and Delrose did not hesitate to walk right through with a six bagger to close out the match in the 10th frame.

Delrose earned the top seed following 8 games of qualifying with a 1,617 total, 20 pins better than Rodriguez. The championship round started with Quintero (#3 seed) and 13-year old rising star and three time Indiana Middle School State Champion Kylee Trexler (#4 seed) advancing to the semi-finals knocking out Monica Colon. The two would then be joined by Rodriguez in the semi's and it would be the end of Trexler's galliant run.

The ladies field of 35 averaged 168.7 with 181.2 average required to make the first cut. The championship round required an average of 187.6.

Delrose collected \$325 for her efforts. A total of \$1,125 was split amongst 7 players. Also cashing were Rodriguez, Quintero, Trexler, Colon, Heather Waters and Sara Finke. Trexler also was the recipient of the bowling ball as a result of winning the "Beat the Alum" competition. Delrose was awarded the U20 junior gold spot for the ladies.

# BOWMAN RIDES THE GUTTER FOR SECOND NWIJTPA TITLE

**Top Seed Nolan, NWIJTPA Legend McCune fall in electrifying finale**

Indianapolis' Nik Bowman led the 37-person boys field after the initial 6-game qualifier with 1,271 but limped into the championship round as the 4th seed following two lackluster games during the advancers round. The two-time high school state champion made a move right and topped Kade Metzka and Avery Wolf in round one, then topped Wolf and McCune in round two to roll into the title match with confidence and momentum. In the three player finale, Bowman, McCune, and top seed Alex Nolan (Mokina, IL) took turns as the frontrunner throughout the match seemingly allowing each other to draft and save energy for the stretch run. And, it was Bowman that had the crowd on their feet with his fearless play late in the game, riding the gutter for five consecutive bombs to secure a 226-213-212 win.

The field of 37 averaged 177.1 while an average of 188.0 was required to advance to round 2. The average required to advance to the championship round was 197.8

Bowman collected \$325 for his win as well as an Apparel EFX NWIJTPA Champions jersey and banner. Eight players shared in the \$1,275 scholarship pool. Cashers included McCune, Nolan, Wolf, Metzka, Alex Acosta, Grant Oehler, and Nolan Blessing. The junior gold spot was awarded to Bowman.

# COLON, COFFMAN CAPTURE FIRST D-TOUR TITLES

**Isabella Colon downs Diamond Gist, Aydan Coffman upends top seed Daveon Bickcom**



In the inaugural NWIJTPA D-TOUR Greater Calumet Open, Isabella Colon (Crest Hill, IL) defeated Diamond Gist (Hammond) 178-168 to earn the champions jersey and banner. Gist advanced to the finals with a 188-167 win over Malaya Chavez (Plainfield, IL). A total of 7 girls challenged the difficult conditions, averaging 157.2 during qualifying.

For the gentlemen, Elwood IN's Aydan Coffman defeated Chicago's Daveon Bickcom 146-134 in the title match. In the semi-finals, Coffman rolled by Highland's Trevor Jacobs 214-135.

Junior Gold spots were awarded to Colon and Bickcom.

The 9-player boys field averaged 159.8 during qualifying.
