

NORTHHOUSE, MENDEZ ROLL TO HIGHLAND TITLES

JR TEAM USA Member WINTERS Tosses Tour's 4th 300 in History

Grand Rapids, MI's David Northouse struggled out of the gate with a 173 but rebounded with games of 236, 214, 220, 221 and 223 to secure the top qualifying seed in the field of 53 boys. He continued his string of 200's through the advancers round with a 225-150 victory over Kole Matzke, 215-165 over Jakob Sisk, and then in the title match against NWIJTPA superstar Kevin McCune 239-200. Northouse, a Davenport University recruit, earned his first NWIJTPA

title as well as the \$375 scholarship prize, the Apparel EFX jersey, and the KR Strikeforce Hammer Deuce bowling bag backpack. The dominating rightly went unbeaten in bracket play.

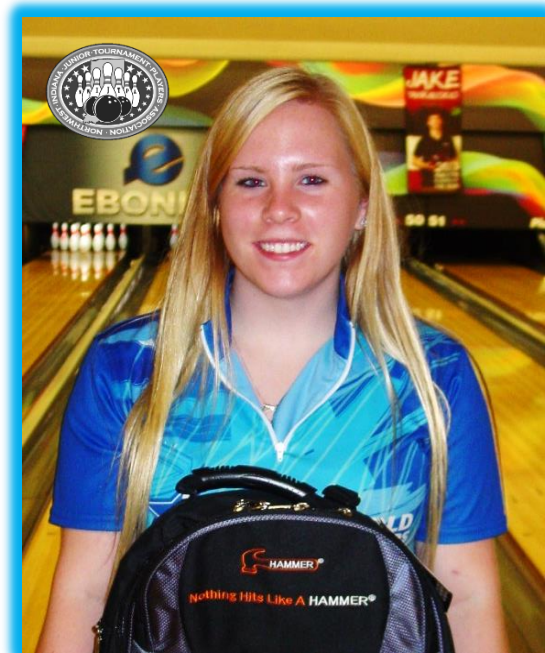
McCune who was going after his tour leading 8th win advanced to the title match with wins over Bolingbrook's Alex Acosta (247-194), and twice over Livonia, MI's Ryan Winters (218-212) and (182-169). McCune earned \$275 plus he grabbed one of two junior gold spots for the boys. Third place finishers were Winters and Sisk. Winters, after falling to McCune, in a winners bracket match, electrified the crowd with a display of power that has rarely been seen on the NWIJTPA tour by firing the tour's 4th 300 in its 7-year history in a contenders bracket elimination game against Acosta. Acosta and Chicago's Manuel Sanchez shared 5th place while Laporte's Kole Matzke, and Portage's Blake Raynor finished 7th. Other scholarship winners on the boys side were Chris Albanese, Austin Schultz, and Indianapolis' Nikolas Bowman.

The second junior gold spot for the boys was secured by Jakob Sisk while Cayleb Carey was the U-15 high qualifier scholarship recipient. Northouse also earned the high qualifier free entry award.

The boys field averaged 173.6 on the difficult WTBA Mexico City pattern. A 195.6 average was necessary to advance to the bracket play.

Homer Glen's Nicolette Mendez garnered her third career NWIJTPA title with a dramatic 197-194 win over Stephen F Austin State freshman Sarah Voiers. Despite an early miscue, Mendez was able to find two doubles during the middle and latter frames to overtake Voiers in the 9th frame. Voiers' 194 was a clean mistake free game.

Mendez advanced to the title match in impressive fashion as she stunned Kentwood MI's Macailin Rodriguez in the event's highest scoring match, 280-248. Rodriguez, who found herself in 22nd after four games regrouped and rolled 207-244 to jump to fifth enroute to her 3rd place finish. Voiers (7th seed) opened match play with a loss to Lockport, IL's Bailey Delrose but then managed four consecutive wins including a dramatic come from behind win over Montgomery IL's Haley Douglas in the semi-finals.

Mendez collected \$350 as well as the champions prize package, while Voiers (\$250), Douglas (\$150), Rodriguez (\$150), Delrose (\$120) ,

Alyssa Foster of Laporte (\$120), Crown Point's Cristina Camp (\$90), and Dyer's Megan Heflin (\$90) were other finalists

and scholarship winners. Heflin also earned a free entry for being the high qualifier. Cicero, IN's Keagan Trexler earned the final girls scholarship award.

Girls junior gold spots were earned by Sarah Voiers and Zeeland, MI's Cristina Scheuerman. Scheuerman edged Indianapolis' Baylee Dill in a one-game roll-off for the final spot. The girls field of 43 averaged 160.6 as a group while a 176.5 average was required to advance to bracket play.

In total, \$3,135 was awarded at the event in scholarship winnings while another \$375 was placed into the year end pool. When including the Champions prizes and high qualifier awards, a 102% payback was achieved on the standard \$40 member entry fee.

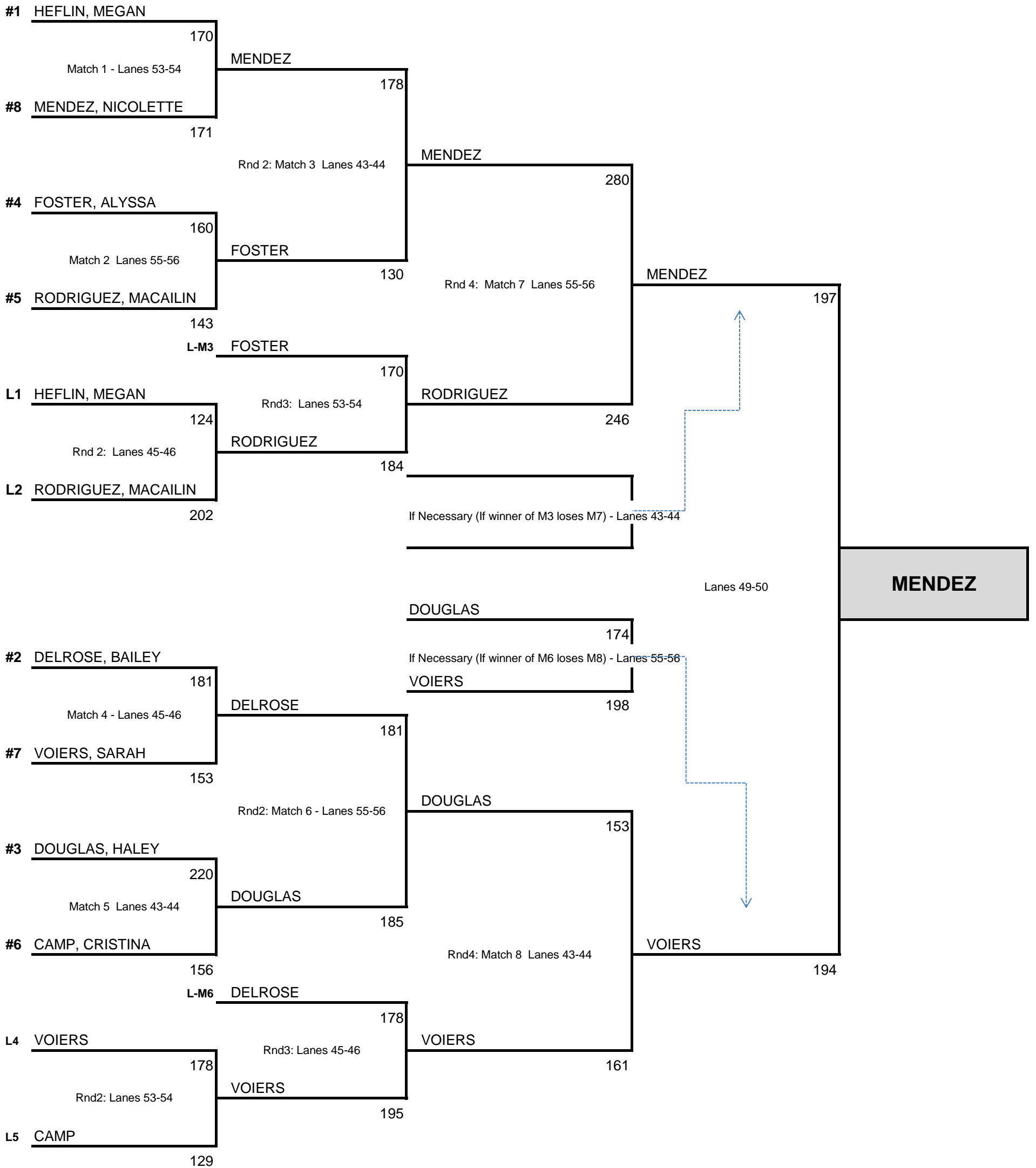

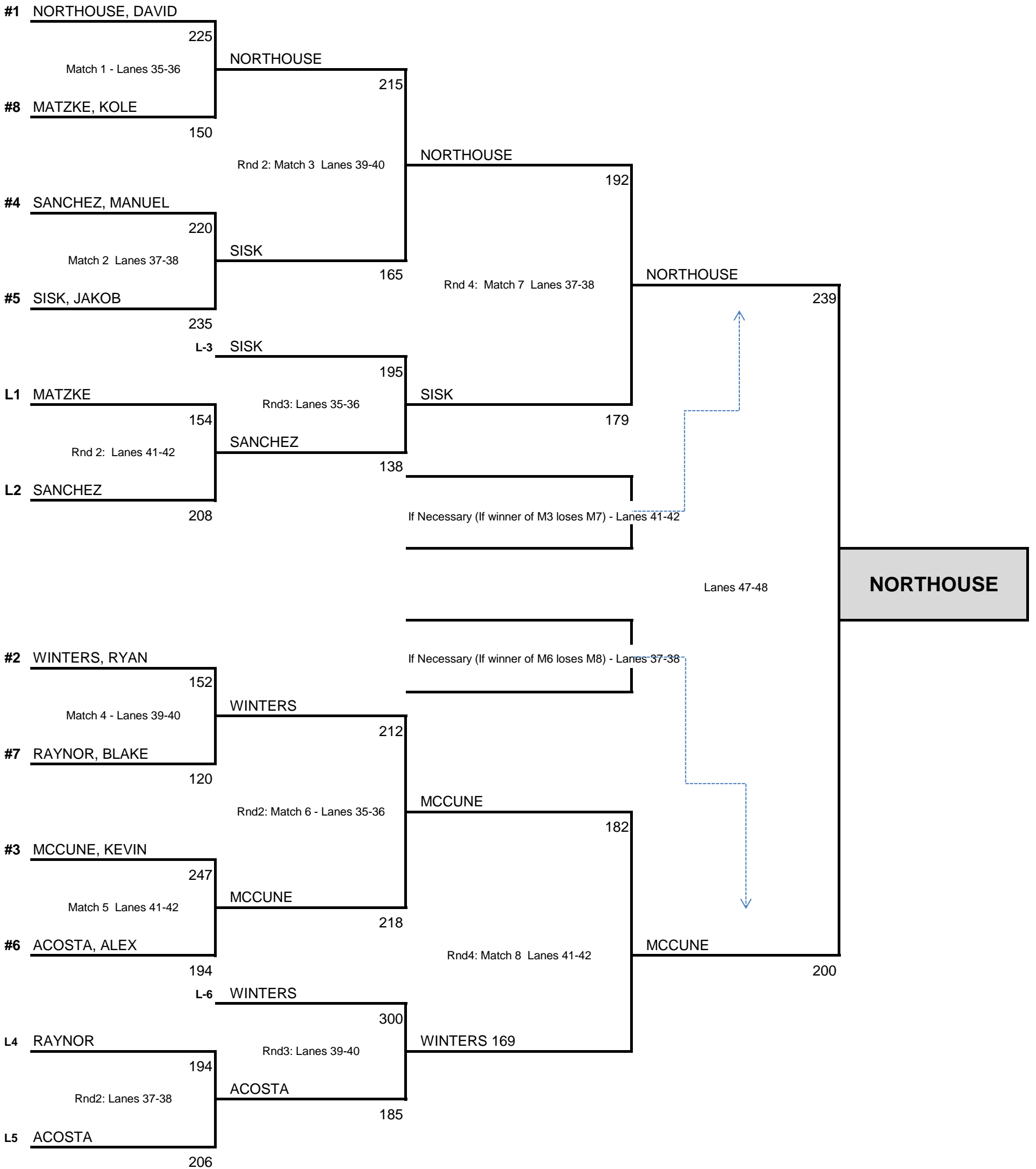
