

CAREY, SHEPHERD BACK IN THE WINNERS CIRCLE

Carey earns 10th career girls title, Shepherd earns 6th career boys title

A field of 48 boys and 22 girls ascended on Arrowhead Bowl in Lafayette Indiana to battle for the NWIJTPA's Lafayette Open crowns. All bowlers fought through six grueling games of qualifying on a brutal 35 foot custom NWIJTPA pattern by CCSJ assistant coach and former NAIA All American Sammy Krucek. Following qualifying, the top 10 boys and top 10 girls moved to the advancers round where seeds 3-10 faced off in head to head matches to determine which two would advance to the championship round along side the top two seeds. The top qualifiers for the boys were Jalen Mosley (Indianapolis) with a 1,190 and Daniel Brown (Crown Point) with a 1,174. These two would eventually be joined in the finals by Jordan Shepherd (Noblesville) and Jeffery Mann (Lafayette). Shepherd defeated Nolan Blessing (Cincinnati OH) and Dakota Solonka (Indianapolis) while Mann took care of Alex Nolan (Mokena, IL) and Kevin McCune (Munster). In the semi's, Shepherd rolled past Brown while Mann, a member of Junior Team USA and the 2016 Junior Gold Champion, came from behind to defeat Mosley in a thriller. In the title match, former Marian University teammates faced off, with veteran NWIJTPA member Shepherd taking down first time NWIJTPA finalist Mann in the two game total pin match 406-370 to capture his 6th career crown, second most in NWIJTPA history.

Shepherd collected \$400 for his efforts. Overall, nearly \$1,800 was awarded to 11 boys, including U15 high qualifier Trevor Bos. Junior Gold spots were earned by Kevin McCune and Jordan Shepherd while the high qualifier award was given to Mosley. The boys field averaged 163.0 as a group while an average of 177.5 was required to advance to match play.



The top qualifiers for the girls were Maryssa Carey, Hobart, with a 1,079 and Michigan City's Megan Grams with a 1,039. These two would eventually be matched up against Indianapolis standout Chelsey Jines and Columbia City's Brittney Kinney (2017 Lafayette Open Champion).

Jines defeated Mikayla Schramm and Lauren Tomaszewski along her road to the championship round while Kinney advanced with victories over Kaitlyn Yearsich and Keagan Trexler.

In the first semi-final Jines jumped out to an early lead over Grams and held on in game two to secure a tight 284-273 nail biter, while in the opposite

semi-final, Carey ran away from her Indiana Tech teammate Kinney by a 435-321 margin. The championship match was all Carey as Jines appeared to have lost her ball reaction allowing Carey to cruise to her 10th career title 375-296.

Carey collected \$275 for her victory while 7 girls shared in a payout of nearly \$1,000. The top U15 qualifier award was captured by Shayla Gwynn (Anderson) while the junior gold spot was awarded to Jines. Carey all earned the high qualifier award for the girls. The girls overall average was 157.9 while a 161.0 average was required to advance to match play.

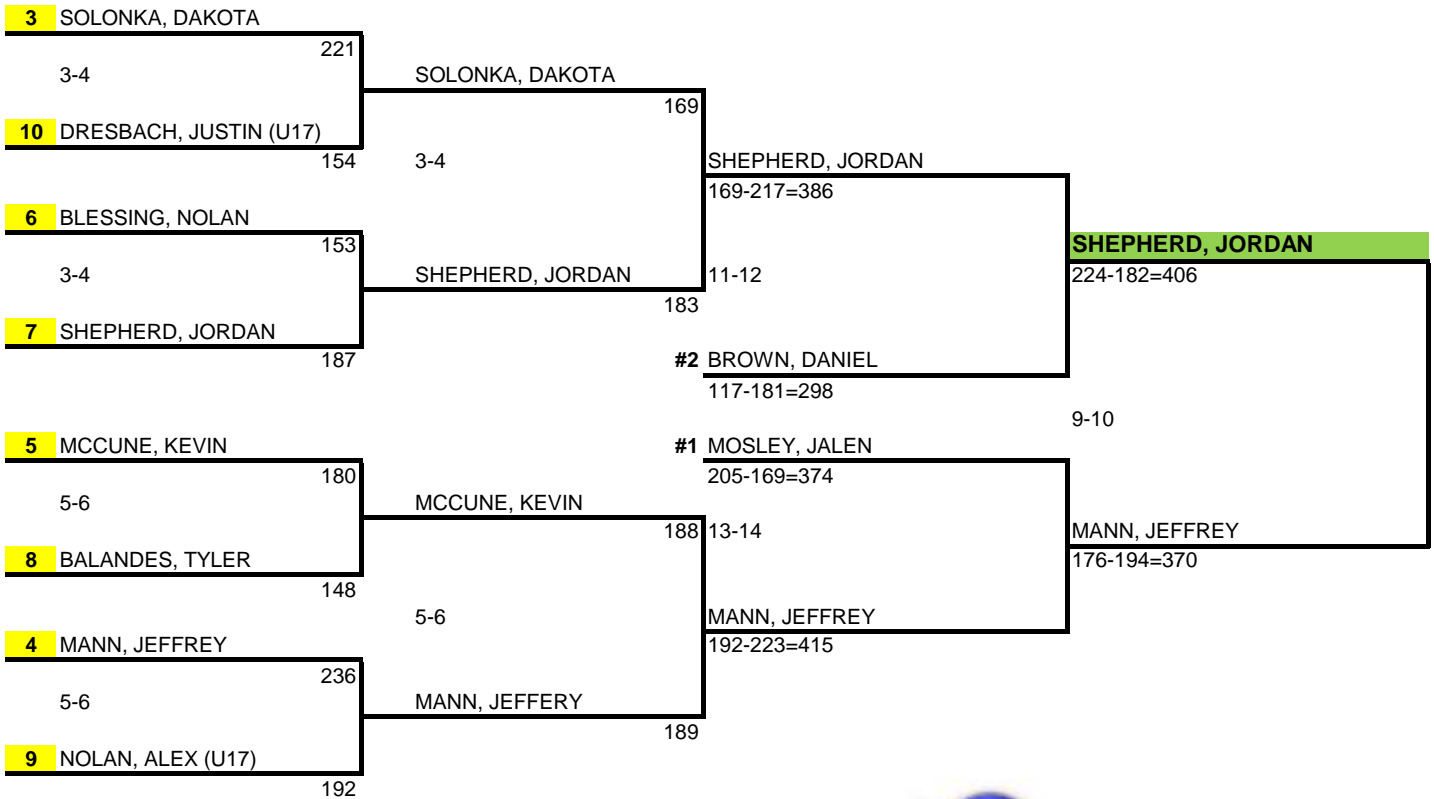
