

NEW CHAMPIONS EMERGE FROM LAKE COUNTY OPEN FIELD

Brandt, Norton join Growing List of NWIJTPA Champions



In the largest field of the season (61 bowlers) two first time champions were crowned for the second consecutive event. Highland's Lindsey Norton defeated a field of 27 competitors, including 2014 Indiana High School Bowler of the Year Jackie Rhoda in the title match, to earn her first title while Fremont Michigan's Sam Brandt, following several top finishes, outperformed a field of 34 to lay claim to his first NWIJTPA title.

The girls field was trimmed to six finalists following a 6-game qualifying block. Heidi Tucker (Chesterton) emerged as the top qualifier with a 1,283 total that included a NWIJTPA tournament record 297 game. Tucker who now owns the top two games ever recorded on tour also takes over the second spot on the series record list with her qualifying total. 4-time champion Jackie Rhoda earned the second qualifying position with an 1,183 set. Competing in her first NWIJTPA 13-year up and coming phenom Keagan Trexler, younger sister of former Indiana High School Bowler of the Year Aubree Trexler, proved that she was not intimidated going against a wealth of established high school stars by securing the 3rd position with her 1,131 total. Rounding out the top 6 were Norton (4th), Valparaiso University standout Carly Larson (5th), and Aurora Illinois native Jordan Newham (6th). Both Larson and Newham relied on big closing games to edge out a group of five players, all within 15 pins of the cut, led by Highlands, Dannielle Rudnickas.

The bracket finals began with Newham, an elite level player from Illinois, disposing of Trexler 229-157, while Norton edged Larson 170-165. In the semi-finals, Norton stepped up her game, rolling a 236 to run past the top seeded Tucker while Rhoda dominated Newham 256-200, setting up a title match that was a repeat of the Northwest Indiana High School bowling PT Preseason Bowl-o-Rama championship match the day before where Rhoda and Norton were anchors for their respective teams. And once it again, Norton prevailed, this time by the score of 234-192.

Fremont, Michigan's Sam Brandt who has had multiple top 5 finishes this season joined his travel companion Kasey Eaton in the winner's circle with a convincing 254-190 dismantling of Highland standout Tyler Trombetta.

Brandt and Trombetta finished 1-2 during the 34 player qualifying segment with Brandt running away from the field with 1,330. Joining the two in the bracket play finals were newcomer David Northouse, veteran Adam Batliner, Jabar Johnson, and Zach Goodrich.

In round 1, Batliner and Northouse emerged with lopsided wins only to face the daunting task of challenging the top seeds. In the day's most electrifying match, Trombetta struck his way past Northouse 257-248 while Brandt again cruised 245-192.

Scholarships were awarded to the top 7 boys and top 6 girls, in all totaling nearly \$1,500 with some \$350 also going towards the year end tournament scholarship fund.

Junior Gold spots were captured by Keagan Trexler (U15), Becky Lohse (U20), Monica Lhames (U20), Danielle Rudnickas (U20), and Jessica Sellers (U20). On the boys side, advancers were Logan Rosing, Austin Trent, and Zach Carter.

The next event is slated for November 8th at Inmans Recreation Center. The NWIJTPA Crusader High School Showcase will begin at 5pm immediately following the Women's NCAA Crusader Classic featuring 14 of the top women's NCAA teams in the country. It is expected that several coaches will be in attendance. This field will fill, so do not hesitate to get your entries in.



Boys Finally Get on the Board in 2014 - Hand Girls first Battle of Sexes loss of the Season



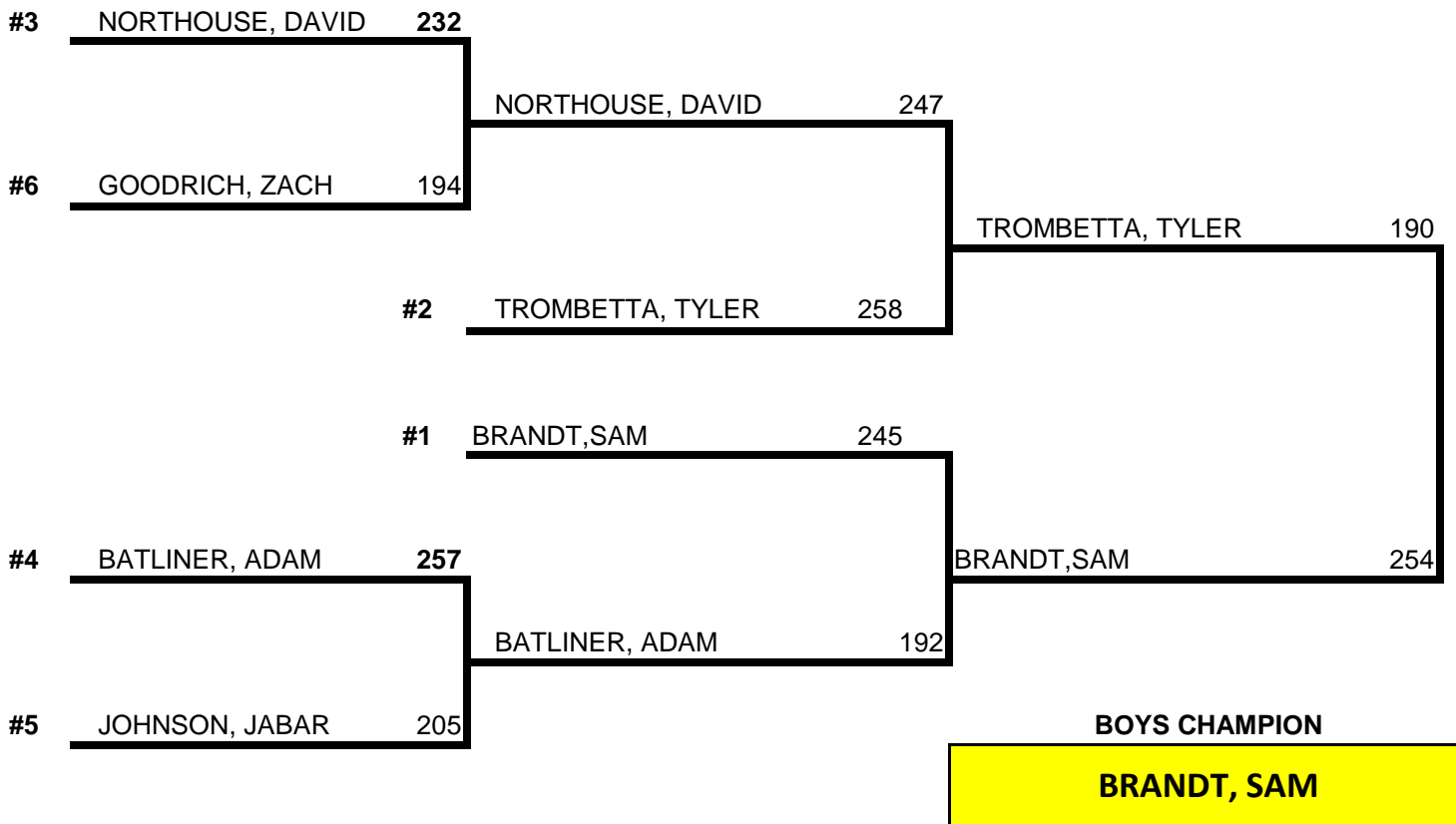

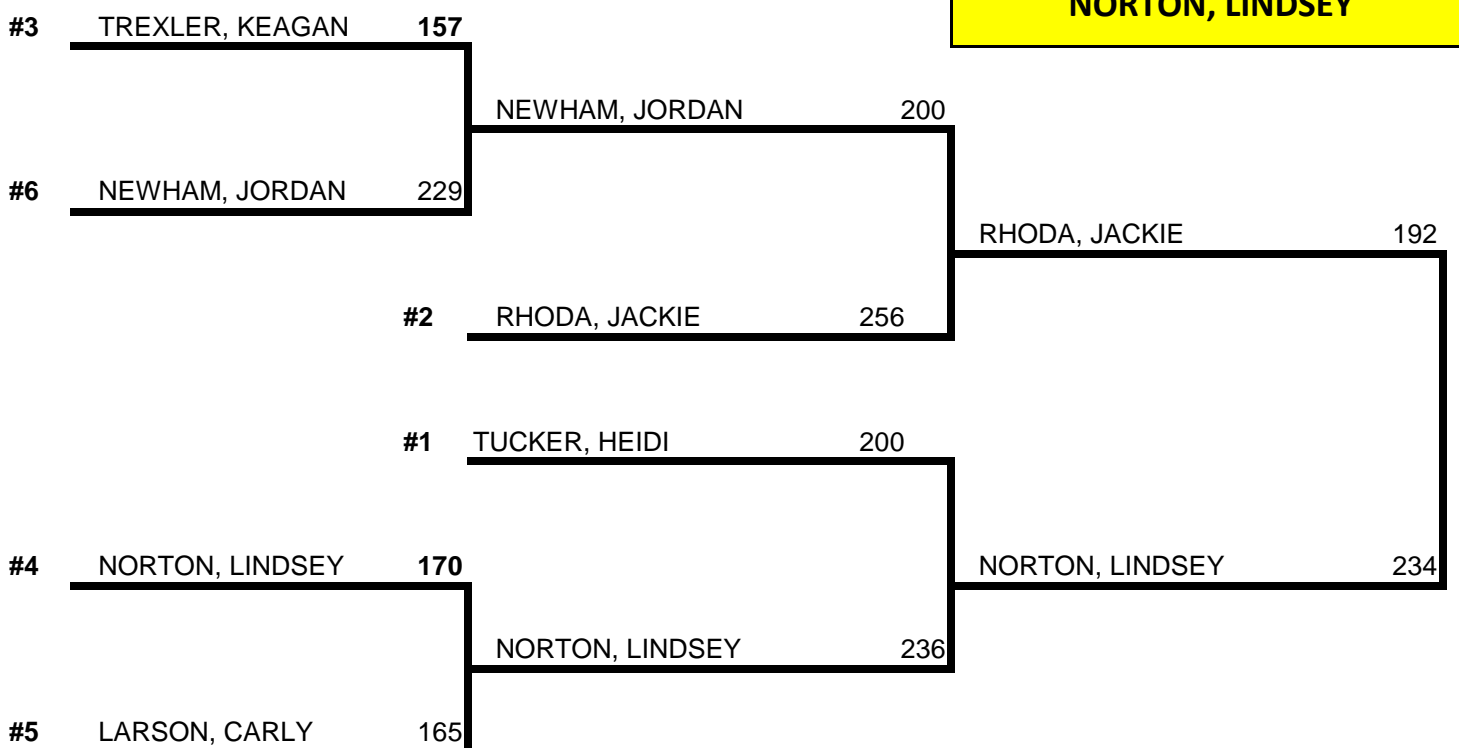
