

AUSTIN JORDAN Breaks Through for First NWIJTPA Title

Ancilla College sophomore outlasts 8-time champion McCune 245-224 in finale

Ancilla College sophomore Austin Jordan (Knox, IN) advanced to his first NWIJTPA championship match only to face off against the tour's most decorated champion and last months winner in Kevin McCune (Munster). Both players struggled early on with McCune taking an early lead only to see the gutsy Jordan string together three consecutive strikes in the middle frames and then close with the final five to finish with a 245-224 victory. A late strike barrage from McCune was not enough to phase Coach Franklin's super sophomore when clutch time

rolled around. Jordan, seeded #11 in the 14 player finals, defeated Ian Ridgway (Naperville, IL), Jalen Mosely (Indianapolis, IN), Tiler Levesque (Acushnet, MA), and Christopher Albanese (Griffith, IN), while McCune's road to the final as the top qualifying seed required only one win over Zachary Carter (Portage, IN). Levesque started the championship round play off with a bang, firing the tour's fourth 300 game in its history, defeating Livonia MI's David Winters 300-183. Winters was making his first appearance in an NWIJTPA championship round. Other finalists included Joey Munsie (St John, IN), Alex Acosta (Bolingbrook, IL), Daniel Brown (Crown Point, IN), Grant Oehler (Carmel, IN), and Dakota Solonka (Indianapolis, IN). Jordan collected \$325 in scholarship winnings while McCune earned \$225. Albanese and Oehler punched their junior gold tickets to Dallas. The boys field of 49 averaged 176.6 on the WTBA Tokyo 42 foot pattern. An average of 194.6 was required to move into the championship round.

CAREY Wins #9, Defeats First Time Finalist Mikayla Himden 189-179

The girls championship match paralleled the boys in many aspects with one exception, the decorated tour champion defeated the first time finalist in the title match. Indiana Tech freshman Maryssa Carey, the top seed, overcame two late miscues and held on to hold off Portage senior Mikayla Himden 189-179 to claim her 9th tour title. Himden had an opportunity in the tenth needing the first strike but a stubborn 10-pin kept her from that first elusive title. Himden, the #10 seed, defeated Baylee Dill (Indianapolis, IN), Keagan Trexler (Cicero, IN), Heather Waters (Valparaiso, IN), and Cristina Scheuerman (Zeeland, MI) to advance to the title match, while Carey got past Michigan City's Megan Grams to set up the title pairing. Other finalists included Valparaiso Univ freshman Hannah Forton (Macomb, MI), Alecia Albanese (Griffith, IN), Megan Heflin (Dyer, IN), Samantha Bugno (Highland, IN), 2017 Dexter High School All American Brittney Kinney (Columbia City, IN), Amelia Kiefer (Jasper, IN), and Valparaiso University sophomore Becky Lohse (Chesterton, IN). Carey deposited \$300 into her smart account.

Trexler grabbed the loan junior gold qualifying spot for the girls while Hanover Central's Marissa Metcalfe defeated all U15 competitors to earn the \$50 scholarship.

The girls 34-player field averaged 165.8 for the six game qualifying block with an average of 169.7 required to advance to the championship round.

In total, \$2,605 was awarded at the event in scholarship winnings while another \$320 was placed into the year end pool. When including the Champions prizes and high qualifier awards, a 97% payback was achieved on the standard \$40 member entry fee.

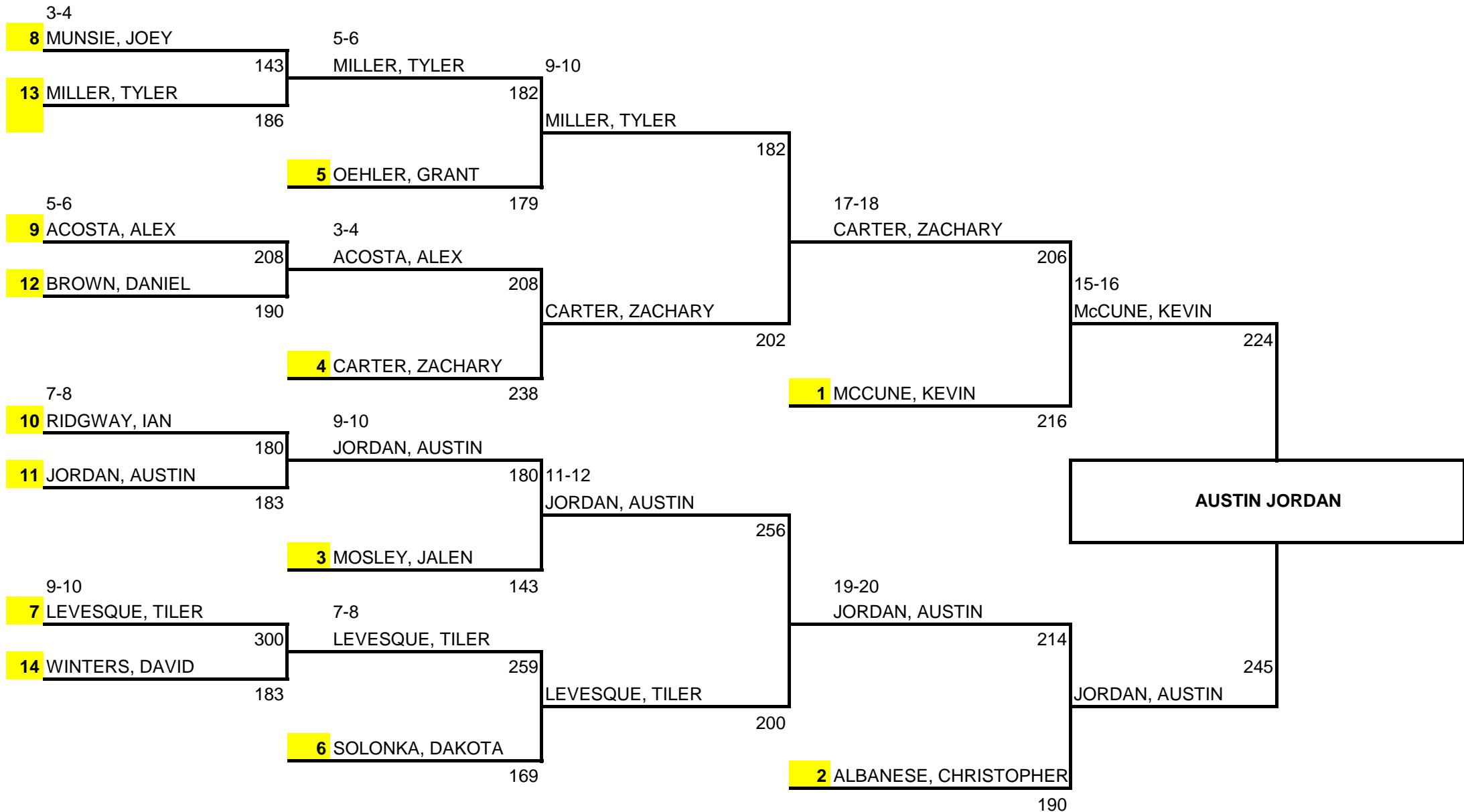

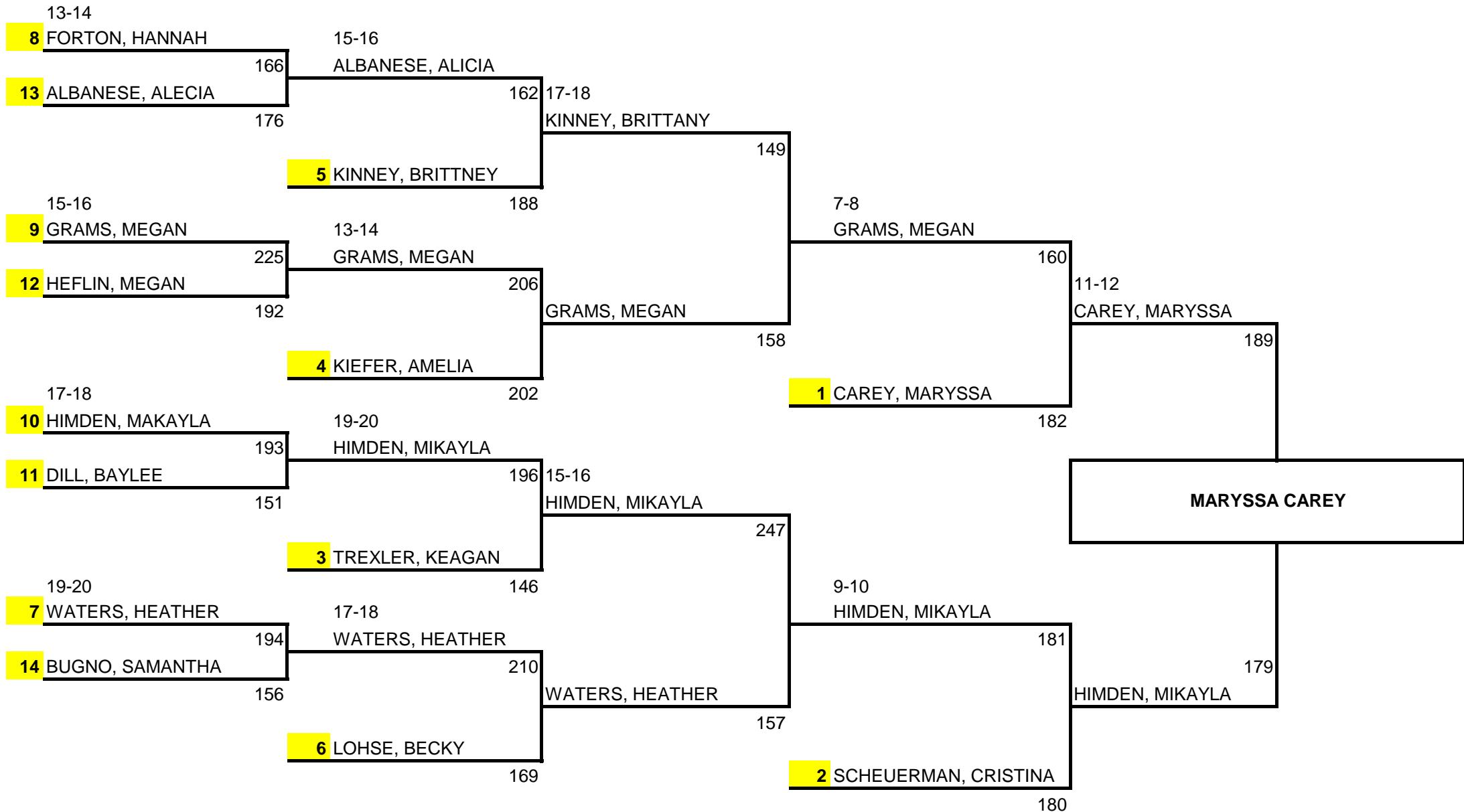
