

# ACOSTA, RODRIGUEZ ADD TO IMPRESSIVE RESUMES

## Mid Season Major title is Rodriguez' second major, Acosta's third major

The 2019 NWIJTPA Mid Season Major featured 45 of the tour's top players, 24 boys and 21 girls, battling three treacherous conditions over the course of two days and as expected the cream rose to the top. The tour's most dominant players through the first half both emerged victorious, adding yet another major title to their already impressive resumes.



Maryville University sophomore sensation Macailin Rodriguez captured her seventh NWIJTPA tour title and second major in thrilling fashion, defeating collegiate teammate Bailey Delrose and Union, KY super junior Ranelle Ulanday. After both Delrose and Ulanday defeated previously unbeaten Rodriguez in the first title match, forcing the "if necessary" round, Rodriguez regained her ball reaction and spare shooting accuracy and emerged with the hardware in a low scoring but exciting title match.

Ulanday, the event's top seed, finished third while Delrose found herself the "bridesmaid" for the 12th time. Keagan Trexler claimed fourth while Kadence Bottrall (Dorr, MI) and Brittany Kinney (Indiana Tech) rounded out the top six.

Other finalists included Brooklinn Chavez, Carly Zuklin, Noelle

Doody, and Karli VanDuinin. Rodriguez earned \$350 in SMART funds while Delrose collected \$250 and Ulanday \$185. Keagan Trexler earned her junior gold nationals spot.

Similar to the ladies side, the gentlemen's competition also came down to the "if necessary" match as both Cameron Crowe and Alex Acosta defeated previously unbeaten Trevor Anifer. Anifer, an 8th grade standout from Lemont, IL defeated Acosta earlier in the day during the battle of the unbeaten. The "if necessary" match quickly became a two-man race as Crowe faded early as Acosta and Anifer struck at will. But it was the veteran Acosta that continued to strike, ultimately defeating Anifer 265-244. The St. Xavier Univ., sophomore earned his third NWIJTPA major title and fourth overall.

Will Clark, the Greater Calumet Open Champion, earned the fourth spot while Chris Albanese and Damian Banghart rounded out the top 6. Other finalists included Trevor Amir, Kade Metzka, Nolan Blessing, and Cayleb Carey. Acosta collected \$350, Anifer \$275, and Crowe \$200. In all, \$2,925 was awarded in SMART funds resulting in a scholarship payback ratio of 100% on the entry fee.
