

# WINTERS, TREXLER Top MidSeason Major Fields

Jr Team USA Member Winters ends nearly two year drought to earn 2nd title; High School Star Trexler downs collegiate standouts to register title #2



The season's first major provided some holiday excitement as 58 players ascended upon Hebron Lanes to compete for over \$3,500 in scholarships and prizes in addition to being named as an NWIJTPA major champion.

Players began with a 6 game qualifying block on Saturday afternoon with ten boys and ten girls advancing to day two. The 46ft Boone Grove Wolf pattern played difficult for the girls while the boys enjoyed some success. Leading the girls 20 player field was Indiana Tech freshman Maryssa Carey with 1,108. Sara Finke's 1,001 secured the 10th qualifying spot.

In the boys field of 38, high school junior Chris Albanese lapped the field (1,399) averaging 233, while CCSJ freshman Manuel Sanchez held onto the tenth spot with 1,721. All bowlers then returned for four additional games of qualifying before the 6 round championship bracket would begin. Both Carey and Albanese maintained their top positions while Sanchez made a bold run in games 8-9-10 to jump to third.

Junior Team USA member and University of Wisconsin Whitewater standout Ryan Winters (#2) would be joined in the finals by CCSJ teammates Jakob Sisk and Sanchez. Winters, who was unbeaten would need to be beaten twice. In the "first" title match, Sisk dominated both opponents, as his two game total of 446 bested Winters' 418 and Sanchez's 356, forcing a winner take all match with Winters. Trailing after 7 frames, Winters struck on his final five shots to force Sisk to double in the tenth. Sisk delivered on his first but was wide right on his second, giving Winters his second title on tour by the slimmest of margins, 225-223.

In the girls final, it would be Ancilla freshman Megan Heflin who emerged as the only unbeaten, Carey and High School junior Keagan Trexler. Both Carey and Trexler defeated Heflin in the first match, forcing a one game winner take all match between the three, and it was young phenom Trexler who battled the tough conditions to edge Carey 167-145 to earn her second career title and first major.

The event held at Hebron Lanes was presented by KR Strikeforce, Ebonite International, Otten Trophies, and Apparel EFX. In all \$3,325 in scholarships were awarded with Winters depositing \$400 and Trexler \$275 into their SMART accounts. Both champions also were awarded an EFX champion's jersey and banner, a KR Strikeforce Hammer Deuce bowling bag, and a beautiful trophy provided by Otten Trophies. In all, 21 players shared in the scholarship pool.

The next event is the Youth Adult doubles on December 17th. This event already has a waiting list of non-members, so members are urged to get their entries in prior to the deadline. Non-members will be slotted in based on when they paid, then by when they signed up.

The lone junior gold spot was captured by Megan Heflin. The U15 award went to Connor Pula. High Qualifier awards were won by Albanese and Carey.
