

MCCUNE, VOIERS CAPTURE HARSCO GLOBAL ENGINEERING TITLES

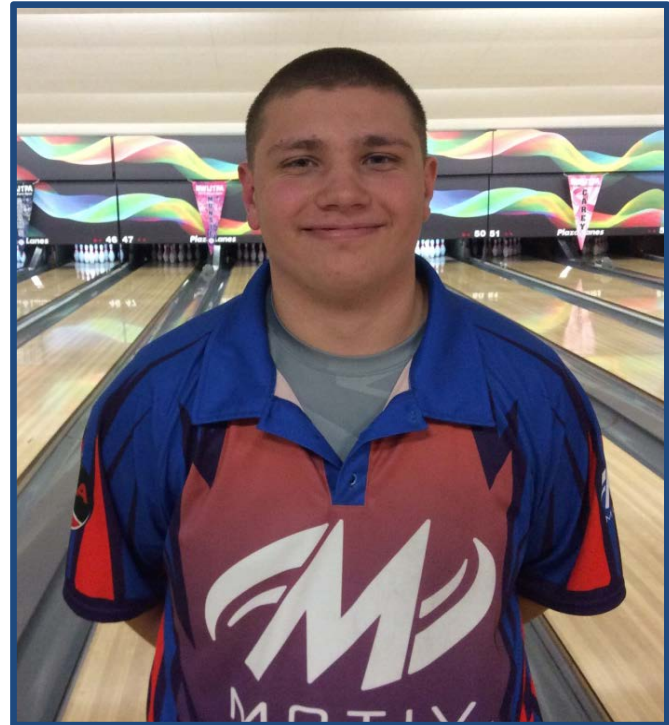
McCune upsets Oehler to earn \$1,000; Voiers edges Eaton, collects \$850

Eighty eight players (54 boys and 34 girls) from four states gathered at Plaza Lanes in Highland IN to compete for the NWIJTPA's 2016 Greater Calumet HARSCO Open title and a share of the largest scholarship pool in NWIJTPA history.

The boys field of 54 was narrowed to two players following six games of qualifying and four additional games of quad-match play competition. Reigning Indiana High School Boys Player of the Year, Carmel Indiana's Grant Oehler secured the top seed on the strength of match play games of 268-247-246-268 and was matched up against #2 seed Kevin McCune of Munster, IN. Oehler and McCune are no strangers as both battled at the Indiana High School state championships a week earlier where Oehler secured second place and McCune 7th.

The title match - two games total pins - was electric from the onset as both bowlers pummeled the pocket only to see heart-stopping corners pins staring back on many occasions. Game 1 ended with McCune ending with a turkey to hold a 226-224 edge. Though bowling for the largest scholarship award in NWIJTPA history, \$1000, neither bowler showed their nerves as both continued to impress with quality shot after quality shot on the difficult WTBA Melbourne pattern. In the end, Oehler fell victim to not only a McCune onslaught of strikes but also multiple seven pins, by a margin of 433-408. This marks McCune's fourth NWIJTPA title.

Other scholarship winners on the boys side included Oehler (\$500), South Bend's Nicholas Graveel (\$250), defending champion Jordan Shepherd of Noblesville (\$200), Griffith standout Christopher "squeaky heals" Albanese (\$150), Illinois products Eric Ullian (\$125), Ryan Koesema (\$100), and Ranzy Collins (\$100). Portage's Austin Schultz collected \$75 as did Michigan City's Lucas Grams, and Morehead State recruit Zachary Carter.

The boys field averaged 173.4 with the match play round cut at 176.3. The top seeded Oehler averaged 219.4 for his 10 games.

On the girls side, Chesterton standout Sarah Voiers upended Grand Rapids Michigan's Kasey Eaton in a thrilling title match 375-371. Voiers entered the finals as the #2 seed, well behind the high scoring Eaton after the 10 game qualifying segment.

After trailing by 5 pins following Game 1, Voiers jumped out early and continued to fill frames down the stretch to earn a 9 pin victory in game 2 and the title, her second overall.

Voiers collected an NWIJTPA record first place award on the girls side of \$850 while Eaton pocketed \$425. Other award winners included Zeeland Michigan's Cristina Schuerman who earned \$250 for her third place finish, Highland's Samantha Bugno (\$200), Dyer's Maddie Blythe (\$150), Elkhart's Brooklynn Schutz (\$125), and Griffith's Kersten Collins (\$100).

The girls field averaged 167.9 while Eaton's 198.5 average led all qualifiers.

Special thanks to our tournament sponsors, HARSCO Engineering and our outstanding host, Plaza Lanes. Mari Albanese and her staff at Plaza set the standard for our tour with their outstanding service and facilities. The dedication and outstanding efforts of HARSCO Engineering's Arthur Olvera and Plaza Lanes allowed the NWIJTPA to award in excess of \$5,500 in scholarships and awards, including a first ever \$1,000 first place award in the boys division.
